HOUSTON (AP) — Hot, hungry and happy Gemini astronauts James A. McDivitt and Edward H. White II plummeted home from space Monday to a red carpet welcome and presidential congratulations — safe after a four-day orbital marathon that included a 20-minute walk in space.

While the doctors examined them, McDivitt and White drank water and grapefruit juice. Then at one point light-haired Ed White peered to dark-haired McDivitt.

Beard and sporting the good humor that relieved their difficult hours in space, the two astronauts splashed down in the Atlantic at 12:11 p.m. Space-walker White became seasick in the buffeting spacecraft, and vomited a little. The helicopter crew that picked them up said the astronauts had washed themselves off with salt water waiting for pickup.
